#### INTRODUCTION...

Our vision has always been clear and purposeful — to ensure all pupils flourish by developing their core skills, supporting them to reveal their character virtues and ensuring all pupils deepen their knowledge of the world around them. This vision is championed by our creative staff team and our supportive families. This vision is designed to support pupils throughout their time at Floreat Wandsworth and beyond.

A key part in developing this vision is to always ask the question 'how can we make our educational offer even better?' A large part of what we do is achieved through our curriculum which is currently full of fantastic learning opportunities for all pupils.

As part of the School Improvement Plan we are looking to develop and improve our curriculum by doing the following:

- 1. Improve on what our curriculum currently offers for pupils in Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 2 & Year 3.
- 2. Develop an inspiring curriculum for our pupils when they enter Years 4, 5 & 6.







#### HOW YOU CAN HELP...

We are looking to form two Floreat Focus Groups consisting of parents to meet and discuss the current educational offer here at Floreat Wandsworth. We will discuss the questions below in addition to points 1 & 2 as detailed above.

- A. What do you feel are the most important aspects of FW's current curriculum?
- B. Is there anything you feel should be included in the curriculum and what are your reasons for this?

There will be two Floreat Focus Groups formed of different parents from all year groups (12 parents maximum in both groups).

One group will meet on Thursday  $14^{th}$  March from 6.30 - 8pm (refreshments will be provided) and the other group will meet on Friday  $15^{th}$  March from 8-9.30am (breakfast for the adults & childcare for Floreat pupils until 8.30am will be provided).

Both meetings will take place at school. We will pick names from a hat if we receive more volunteers than places available.

We will use your written contributions and comments to inspire the focus group conversations (parent names will not be attached to the comments).

The information we gather will be used alongside the views of our own team and educational consultants to help shape our curriculum offer for our pupils.

#### THE SECONDARY SCHOOL INFORMATION EVENING...


