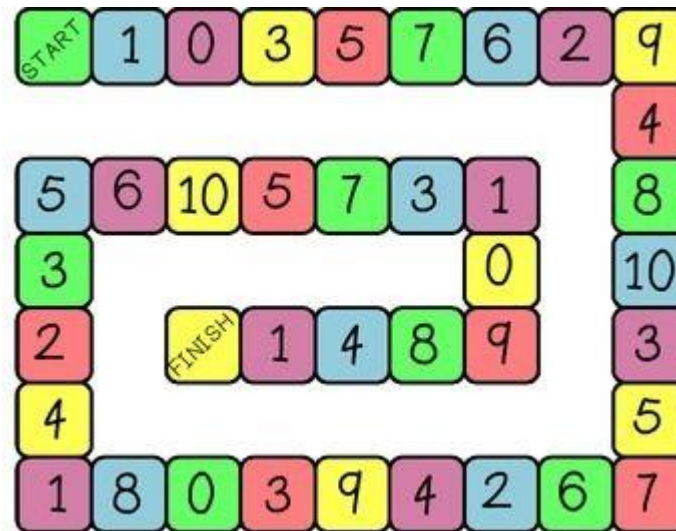
toad
