On Wednesday 9th and Thursday 10th May we had our first full Ofsted inspection. The full report is currently being written and will be available soon.


We are proud of what the whole community has achieved together in the past 3 years and we are already planning ahead to ensure that our pupils flourish in every aspect of school life in the future.
