Dear Parents,

Thank you so much for completing the Parent Questionnaire; your feedback is invaluable to us as we continue to build our lovely school. First and foremost all 80 responses to the questionnaire agreed that their child was **happy** in this school. This is fantastic news! We have also received such wonderfully positive comments with regards to the **energy, creativity** and **warmth of our staff**, our unique teaching style, our nurturing learning environment and the importance of serving others.

There was overwhelming enthusiasm for Floreat's appreciation of mastering our **character virtues** and in turn, the positive effect this is having on the children's development of social, extra-curricular and academic skills. As a means of motivating the children further and deepening their understanding of these important virtues, one parent suggested introducing a point system which rewards children for putting these virtues into practice. This is a great idea that encourages our shared values and we will look into this further as we make our way into the Autumn Term.

Parents also commented that they thought children displayed outstanding **behaviour** in and around the school with the Head Girl and Boy system receiving plenty of praise. A large number of parents from all three year groups remarked how exceptionally proud they were to see their children growing in confidence and independence - we are too! It is important to note that since September 2015 we have not had a single case of bullying.
