




YEAR 4




YEAR 5

Here are some pictures of a Maths lesson where we used concrete manipulatives to support deepening our understanding in the concept of scaling. We used this exploration of the concept to develop the stem 'when you multiply a whole number by a unit fraction, it is the same as dividing by the denominator'.









YEAR 3

In Year 3, we have been immersing ourselves in the Art of Ancient Egypt. Before half term, we created versions of Nefertiti's collar. We also took our English learning outdoors and exercised teamwork to create our own explanation text entitled "How to Get to Hogwarts" using chalk on the playground! The children had a brilliant time creating these and really demonstrated their extraordinary creativity. We then held a competition to see which group could include the most subordinate clauses within their explanation.





YEAR 1

Year 1 have been learning about weather in the first half of the Spring Term. We have looked at the seasons, cloud types and types of weather such as precipitation. We learnt that you can use a rain gauge to measure the amount of rainfall and how to record weather data in a graph. We even got to pretend we were meteorologists by creating and performing our very own weather forecasts!

In Geography, we have been learning about the United Kingdom. We have learnt that the UK is made up of England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. We have looked at atlases and maps of both the UK and our local area. We know that the word 'union' means together.









YEAR 2

Year 2 had an experience day for our History topic, the Romans. A Roman expert came in and talked to us about the history of the Romans including where they lived, and what life was like during that period. We were fully immersed in the day as we dressed up as Romans as well! The Roman expert shared stories of the Roman times and we were able to ask some questions that we had. Some of the highlights of our day were when we played a Roman food game to test our knowledge of foods that Romans ate, and re-enacting a battle that Boudicca had led. Y6 had an Evacuee Theme Day linked to their history learning. Pupils dressed as evacuees, wrote letters home following some drama, explored different sources and replicas to help understand what life was like and even completed some ration cooking!
