Primary Knowledge Curriculum



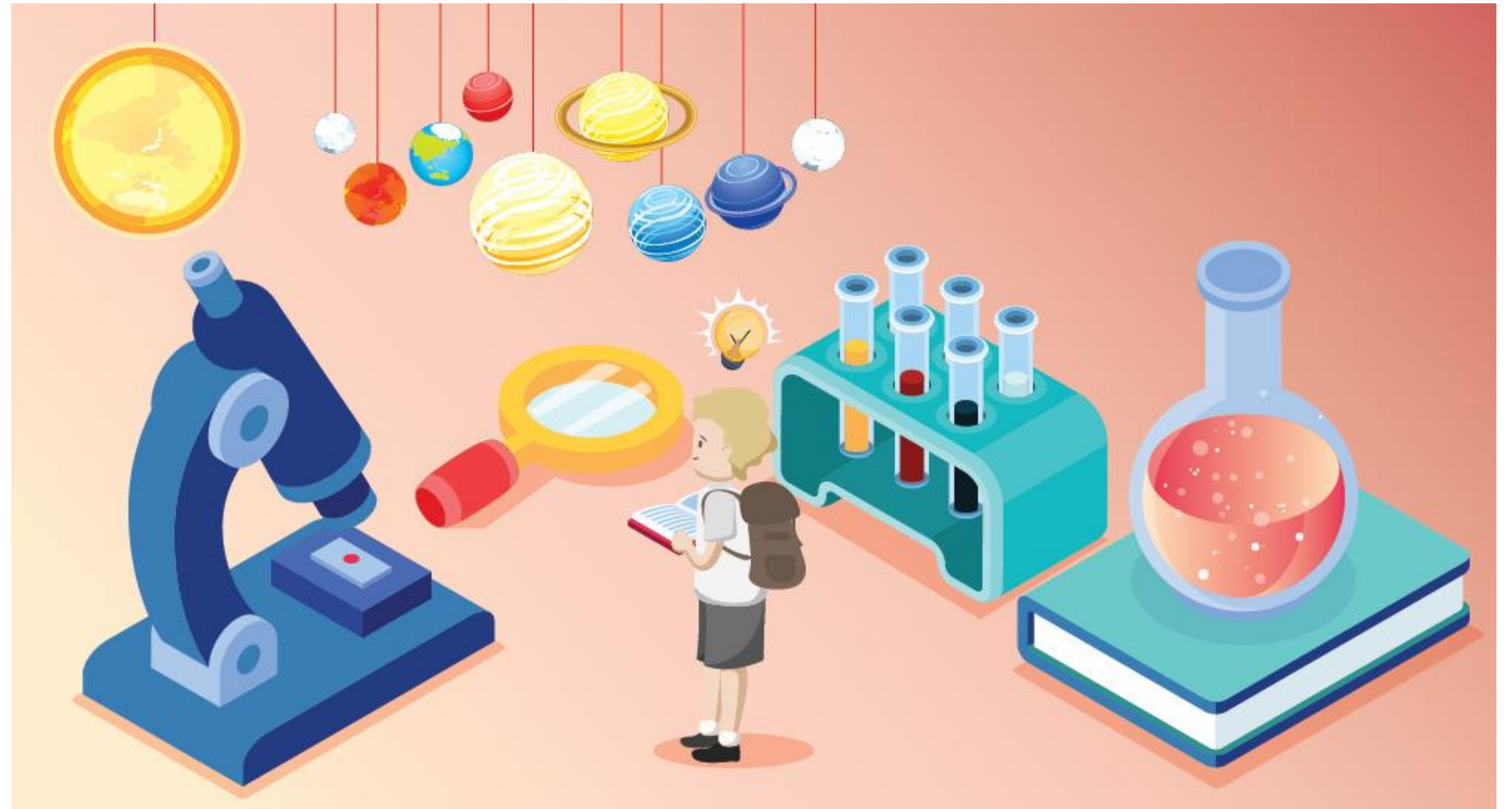
- Powerful knowledge.

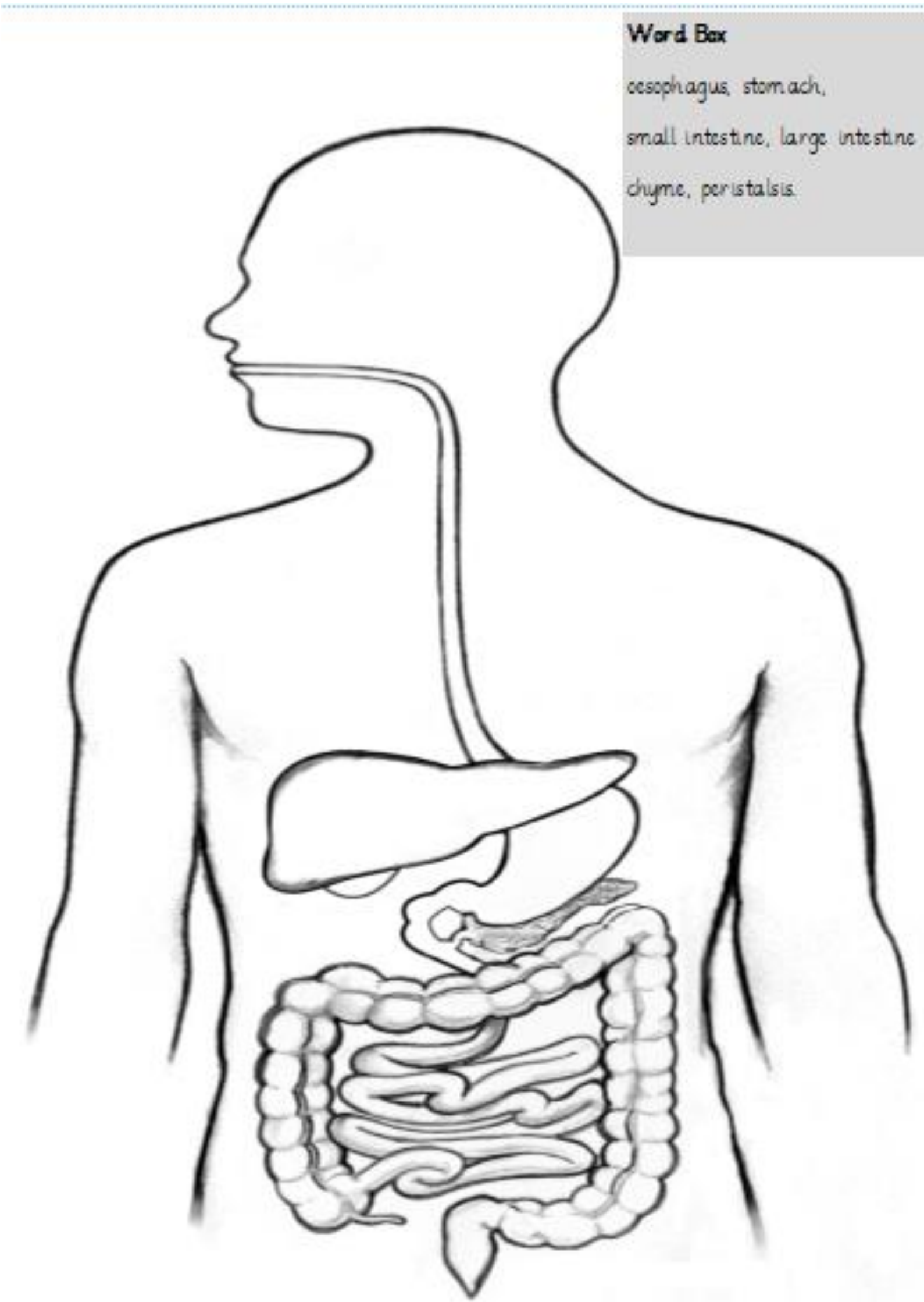
