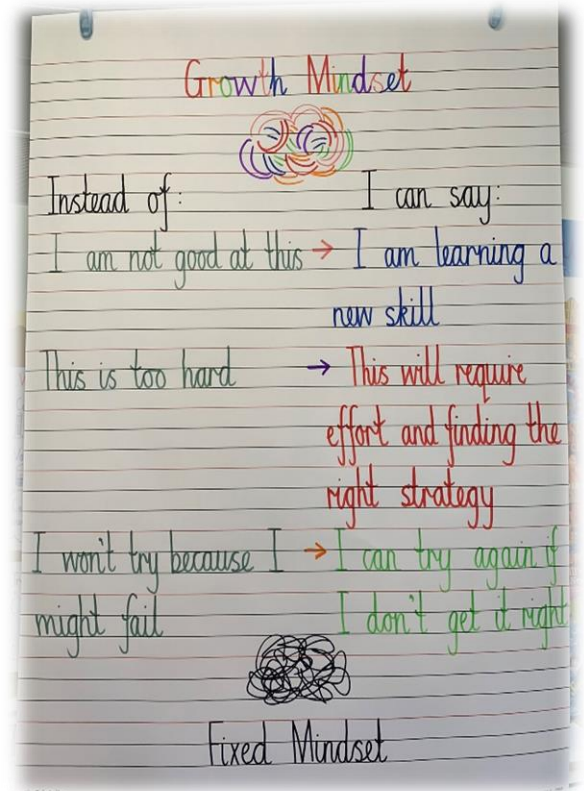

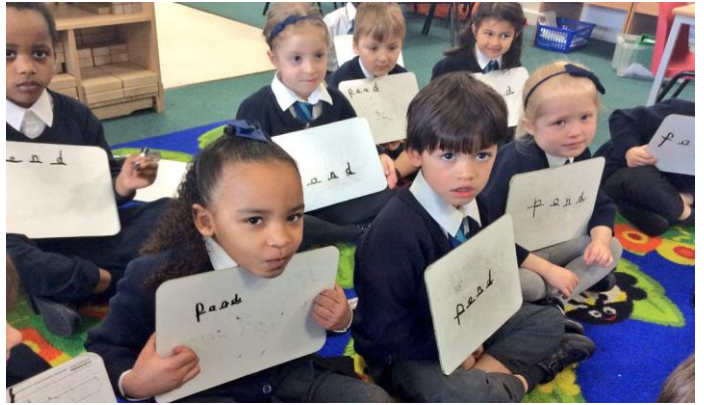

COVID-19 REMINDERS

Please find a list of Covid-19 reminders below:

- Please do not send your child to school if you or any member of your household is experiencing symptoms of Covid-19.
- Please do not send your child into school if you or any members of your household are awaiting the result of a Covid-19 test.
- Parents must follow any quarantine rules if they are returning from overseas. Pupils must not attend school if they have been instructed to isolate as part of their quarantine requirements.

- Gatherings in a public or private outdoor space are not permitted if there are more than 6 people or 2 households in attendance. Members of the public are strongly encouraged by the police and the local authority to report breaches for the safety of our wider community and the organiser and attendees may be issued with fines.
- We understand that the past year has been difficult for everyone and we are grateful to all of you who have been following the guidelines, but organising or attending a large gathering is currently illegal.

COVID-19 UPDATES



From tomorrow, NHS Test and Trace is reintroducing confirmatory PCR testing for positive LFD tests. This means that **if you do get a positive LFD test then you must get a PCR test to confirm the result.**

The PCR test should be booked immediately and be undertaken within 2 days by calling 119 or by [clicking here](#).

If you have a positive LFD test result, all close contacts and other members of their household, should self-isolate immediately while awaiting the PCR result. If the PCR test is negative, it overrides the LFD test and the self-isolation can end.
